ORDINANCE INTRODUCTION:

TOWNSHIP OF LONG HILL ORDINANCE #393-17

CONCERNING PARKING REGULATIONS ON SOMERSET STREET AND AMENDING CHAPTER VII OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE ENTITLED "TRAFFIC"

Statement of Purpose: To amend the traffic code by adding the south side as well as the dead-end portion of Somerset Street east of Main Avenue to the list of streets where parking is prohibited at all times.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Long Hill in the County of Morris, New Jersey that Chapter VII of the Township Code entitled "Traffic" is hereby amended as follows:

Section 1. Section 7-14 entitled "Parking Prohibited at All Times on Certain Streets" is supplemented and amended by adding the south side and the dead-end portion of Somerset Street east of Main Avenue, in alphabetical order, as follows:

7-14 PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALLTIMES ON CERTAIN STREETS.

No person shall park a vehicle at any time upon any streets or parts thereof described.

- **Section 2.** The effectiveness of this ordinance is contingent upon signs being erected as required by law.
- **Section 3.** Any and all other ordinances or parts thereof in conflict or inconsistent with any of the terms hereof are hereby repealed to such extent as they are so in conflict or inconsistent.
 - Section 4. In case any article, section or provision of this ordinance shall be held

invalid in any court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect any other article, section or provision of this ordinance except insofar as the article, section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.
