The Office of Emergency Management is offering CERT training classes this fall starting September 13th.

This FEMA CERT training course is completed in 6 sessions over a 4 week period. Learn how to protect yourself, your family, and assist your neighbors and community during wide spread emergencies and disasters. Classes are free of charge and open to all Long Hill residents (18 and older). No previous emergency service training is required or necessary.

Training sessions will include; First Aid, Homeland Security/Terrorism, Incident Command Structure (NIMS)/CERT Organization, Disaster Medical Operations, Light Search & Rescue, Disaster Psychology, Emergency Communications, Fire Safety and Suppression, Electrical and Natural Gas Safety Awareness, and Disaster Planning. Upon completion students receive a course certificate and become a member of the CERT team.

To enroll you must complete an application. Forms are available at the Office of Emergency Management at Town Hall and the Police Department. Class size is limited, enroll early!
